Kyle White was awarded the Medal of Honor for actions in Afghanistan on November 9, 2007, when two squads and a headquarters element from the 173rd Airborne Brigade Combat Team were ambushed with accurate rifle, machine gun and rocket-propelled grenade fire from multiple fortified attack positions from high ground.
