Scholarship Name: Amos Camden Riley Bock Memorial Scholarship

Purpose: For the purposes of this need-based scholarship program, the recipient will be in the high need category of financial aid. The combined federal adjusted gross income of the student and the student's family, as required to be reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), must be less than or equal to \$40,000 per year and the student must have financial need as defined by federal financial aid regulations. In future years, this amount can be adjusted by the President of the University of Missouri as deemed appropriate.

Selected recipient(s) must be Missouri-residents and have a demonstrated financial need as described above.

First preference shall be given to students attending MU on the GI Bill[®]. If the first preference cannot be fulfilled, preference shall be given to students from New Madrid County, Missouri, majoring in Agriculture, Law or Journalism.

Scholarship amount is up to \$2,000.
